ENGLISH

HISTORY

Our enquiry question this term is:

PSHE

MUSIC

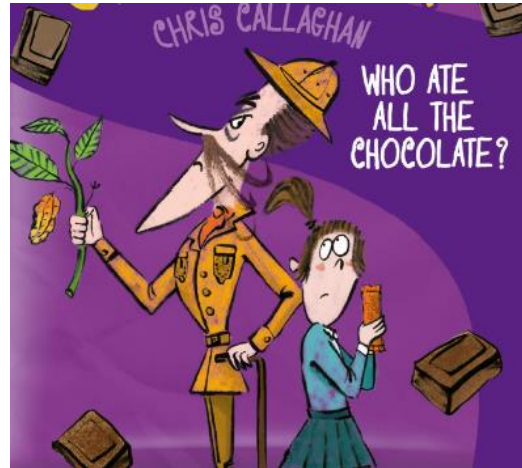
How does music teach us about our community?

DT

The children will be learning about different mechanisms and pneumatic technology. They will be exploring how to make something move using pressurised airflow.

MATHS

We will continue to work on fractions at the start of the term and then move onto decimals. Arithmetic will be practised daily using Fluent in Five. Times tables will be a focus this term ready for the Multiplication Tables Check.



PE

The outdoor lesson will be tennis and indoor lesson will be dance.

SCIENCE

We will be studying Sound this term. The children will learn how sound is made, how we hear and explore sound insulation, pitch and volume.

COMPUTING

The children will consider how and why data is collected and how computers can use special input devices called sensors to monitor the environment. They will then log their own data.

RE

Building upon their knowledge of Christianity, the children will be discussing if forgiveness always possible for Christians.

MFL

We will be learning how to say different commands in French this term such as listen and repeat.
