MUSIC

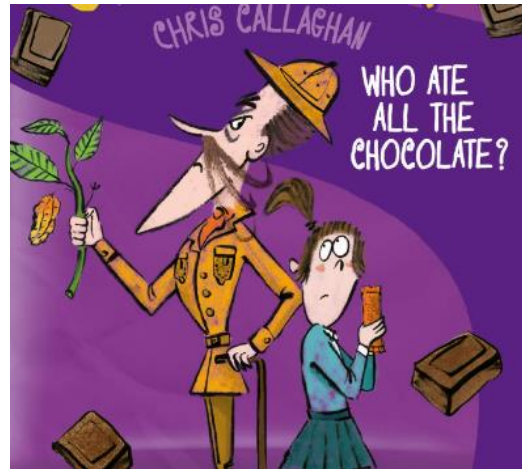
This term, the children will be taking part in Notivate where a musician will come to school to work with the children on creating their own songs. They will then go to his recording studio to record their songs!
