### MATHS

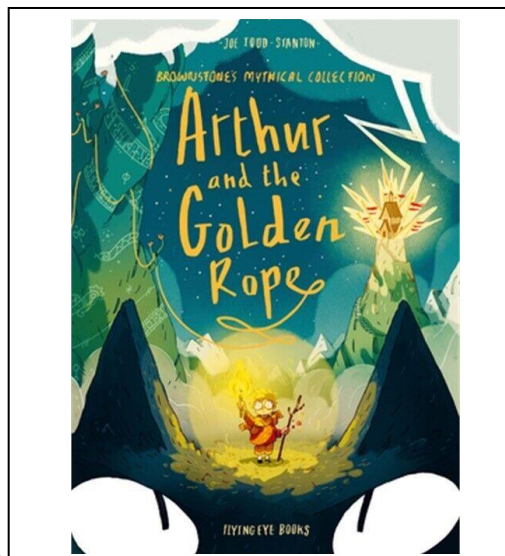
