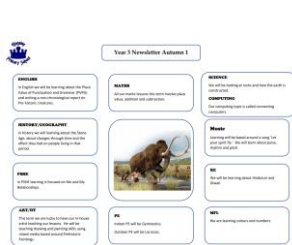
Uniform
