Science

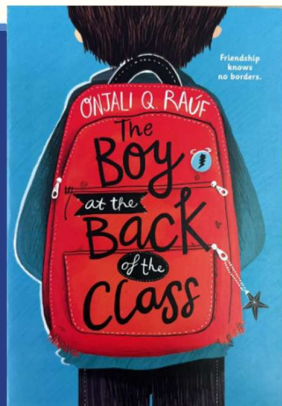
We are learning about sound this term. The children will discover how sound is made, how we hear and explore sound insulation, pitch and volume through conducting experiments.
