# NEWSLETTER



## English

This half term, we'll be using a range of exciting stimuli – including the Battle of Britain – to inspire our writing and help us grow as confident, thoughtful authors. In Reading, we're beginning *High Rise Mystery*, where we'll build our comprehension skills, make predictions, and explore characters as we work together to become resilient, curious readers.

## Maths

This half term, we'll be building our confidence with Perimeter and Area, and Statistics by working with data in meaningful ways, and strengthening our Geometry skills as we learn to describe and reason about shapes. As we move closer to SATs, we'll be focusing on building resilience and perseverance, helping everyone feel confident and ready to tackle challenges with a positive mindset.

## Science

This half term, Year 6 will be learning about *Living Things and Our Environment*. We'll explore how organisms are classified, how they adapt to their habitats, and how environments can change over time. Children will build curiosity and resilience as they investigate the world around them.

## History/Geography

This half term, we'll be learning about the Battle of Britain. Children will explore why it was such an important moment in World War II and learn about the people and events that shaped it. Through discussion and investigation, pupils will develop their understanding of cause and consequence while building confidence in their historical thinking.

## PSHE/RE

In PSHE, we'll be focusing on Healthy Me, learning how to make positive choices for our physical and emotional wellbeing.

In RE, we'll explore the question "Is Christianity still a strong religion 2000 years after Jesus was on Earth?" and discuss different viewpoints to develop thoughtful understanding.



## PE

This term, we'll be developing control, balance, and coordination through Gymnastics, exploring different movements and routines. We'll also be learning key skills in Basketball, including teamwork, passing, and shooting, while staying active and building confidence.

## Art/DT

This half term, we'll be exploring the artwork of Sonny Street, focusing on how he paints wildlife. Children will experiment with colour, texture, and brush techniques to create their own wildlife-inspired pieces while growing their confidence as young artists.

## MFL

This half term, we'll be learning new French vocabulary linked to food, including items like un paquet de chips, une portion de frites, and different flavours of ice cream such as chocolate, strawberry, and vanilla. Children will practise saying these words confidently and using them in simple phrases.

## Music

This half term, we'll be exploring different musical styles and discovering how music helps connect us with others. Children will listen to a range of pieces, discuss how they make us feel, and experiment with creating their own music inspired by these styles.

## Computing

This half term, we'll be learning about data and information through an introduction to spreadsheets. Children will learn how to organise data, use simple formulas, and present information clearly, helping them build confidence with digital tools they'll use across the curriculum.
