Science

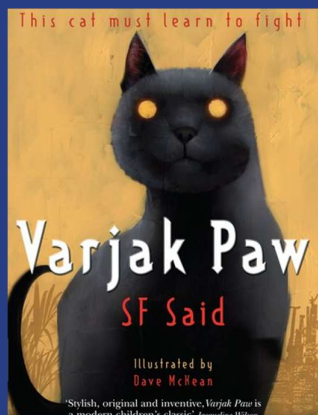
We will be studying Living Things and their Habitats – Conservation. They will understand human impact on the environment and explore air and water pollution.
