English

This half term, we'll be using a range of exciting stimuli (including short films, texts and other sources) to inspire our writing and help us grow as confident, thoughtful authors. In Reading, we're continuing with High Rise Mystery, as well as honing our SATs skills with comprehension work across a broad variety of genres.

Maths

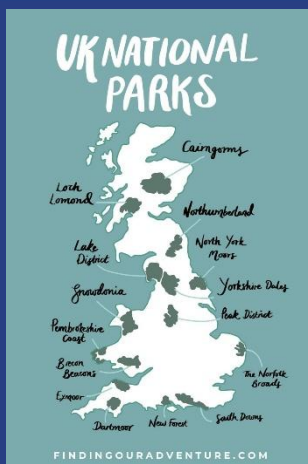
This half term, we'll be building our confidence with a mix of arithmetic and reasoning problems. We will have a mixed focus based on the needs of the children in the build up to the SATs assessments in order to support them to achieve the best that they can do.

Science

This half term, Year 6 will be learning about *Electricity and circuits*. We will be developing children's understanding of how electricity works as well as how this links to the wider world around them. Children will build curiosity and resilience as they investigate the world around them.

History/Geography

This half term, we'll be learning about National Parks. Children will explore what makes these places special, why they are protected, and how people and nature interact within them. We'll build curiosity about the natural world and develop our understanding of how landscapes are cared for.



PSHE/RE

In PSHE, we'll be focusing on Rights and Respect. Children will learn about their own rights and responsibilities, how to show respect to others, and how their choices can help create a kind and supportive classroom community.

In RE, we'll be exploring the question "Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives?" Children will learn about Islamic beliefs, discuss different viewpoints, and think about how faith can influence the choices people make in their everyday lives.

PE

This term, we'll be developing our running, jumping, and throwing skills through Athletics, focusing on control, technique, and working at our personal best. We'll also be learning key skills in Cricket, including batting, bowling, and fielding, while building teamwork and confidence through fun, active games.

Art/Dt

This half term, we'll be creating mixed-media portraits using pen, paint, collage, and even written elements. Children will experiment with different materials and techniques to express themselves creatively and build confidence as young artists.

MFL

This half term, we'll be learning useful French phrases such as "Vous désirez?" (What would you like?), "C'est combien?" (How much is it?), and "Bon appétit!" Children will practise using these expressions in simple conversations and gain confidence speaking French in real-life contexts.

Music

This half term, we'll be exploring Music and Me, thinking about how music can express who we are and how it connects to our feelings and experiences. Children will listen to a range of pieces, reflect on what they hear, and create music that shows their own ideas and identity.

Computing

This half term, we'll be exploring 3D modelling. Children will learn how to create and adapt 3D objects using digital tools, helping them develop spatial awareness, creativity, and confidence in designing models for different purposes.
