English

The children will write a persuasive letter at the start of this term and then write a story based on The Star in the Jar book.

We will continue reading The Dragon in the Library. Spellings continue on Emile for children to practise at home weekly as part of their home learning.

Maths

Our Maths lessons will focus on properties of shape, mass and capacity. We will be revisiting our methods for the 4 operations. Children will continue to use Maths Whizz and TTRS for their homework every week.

PIXLtests will be the week commencing 8th June.

Science

This term, the children will be learning more about scientific enquiry. They will be recording and presenting results, writing a method and carrying out a test, writing a conclusion and thinking about fair testing, controls and variables.

History/Geography

In Geography, the children will be learning about how and why the local area is changing. They will go on a field study trip in the local area to observe and investigate the changes.

PSHE/RE

In RE we will be learning about Humanism and looking at answers to the question what motivates humanists to lead good lives?

PSHE – the topic for this term is growing and changing.



PE

The children will be learning to play cricket this term and they will also complete outdoor adventure activities which will involve leading others and being lead and learning about collaboration and competition.

Sports Day is on Tuesday 30th June in the morning.

Art/DT

For DT this term, the focus for children will be creating structures linked to the previous History unit on Castles. They will design a castle using geometric shapes to build a complex structure. When they have built their castle, they will evaluate their work.

Music

‘Reflect, Rewind and Replay’ is the topic for music this term with the learning focused around revisiting songs and musical activities, a context for the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music.

MFL

In French this term, the children will be learning about ice creams and months of the year.

They will also be able to say numbers to 20 in French.

Computing

Events and actions in programs – is the unit for this term. Children will be coding to move a sprite in different directions and then they will design and code their own maze program.
