

Our Intent

At Kingsley, we want to enable children to express their ideas and thoughts in French and provides opportunities to interact and communicate with others both in speech and in writing. We want our pupils to acquire basic skills and understanding of French, with a strong emphasis placed on developing their Speaking and Listening skills. These will be embedded and further developed alongside Reading and Writing and Grammar. We intend to inspire pupils to develop a love of languages and to expand their horizons to other countries, cultures and people. We aim to help children grow into curious, confident and reflective language learners and to provide them with a foundation that will equip them for further language studies.

How do we do this?

- We give our pupils to opportunity to speak, read and write in French.
- Discuss the differences within our cultures and celebrate theses accordingly.
- We utilise the key vocabulary and grammar provided within the curriculum.
- We ensure that French becomes a frequent part of the day to allow the pupils to become more familiar and at ease with the difference language.
- We encourage the pupils to engage in conversations in French.
- Recap the previous learning so that pupils can clearly see the progression.
- Start teaching French from the early years to being to build up knowledge at an early age.
- Utilise the French language to broaden and strengthen pupils' vocabulary and grammar knowledge.
